Updates from PEERS Happy New Year!



We hope everyone is off to a great start in 2022. PEERS is looking forward to this year because it is our **45-year Anniversary!** That's right! **PEERS is 45**

We are going to start parenting classes on January 10, 2022, Monday with Group Triple P which is a 9-week class and will run until March 14, 2022. On Tuesday, January 11, 2022, the Stress and Ander Management (SAM) begins and will run for 5 weeks until Feb 8, 2022. Starting Wednesday, January 12, 2022 starts Substance Abuse Recovery Nurturing (SARN) class and will run for 18 weeks until May 5, 2022. Thursday, January 13, 2022 we begin with Early Childhood Nurturing (ECN) and this class will run for 16 weeks until May 5, 2022.

Classes will be M-Th from 6-8PM The longer classes like Group Triple P, SARN and ECN will have dinner starting at 5:30PM. All classes are free to Onslow County residents. We also offer free childcare for class participants. Call PEERS to make a referral 910-333-9725 to Ms. Sam or Ms. Katie. Check out our Facebook page for more information.

Our Adolescent Parenting Program has immediate openings for any teen who is pregnant or parenting under the age of 20. This is a free incentive-based program. Teens will earn enough points to provide their child with toys, diapers, wipes, car seats, pack n plays and sleep sacks while they remain in the APP program. to make a referral call Ms. Kristin at 910-333-9725.

Our free childcare is accepting children. Monday, Wednesdays or Friday from 9:00AM-1:00PM families can use this for children ages 5 and under who are not in another childcare setting. Childcare can be used up to 1 day a week, reservations are required. Ms. Sam will be happy to send parents the intake packet or come by PEERS for a walk through of the childcare rooms.

Adolescent Parenting

Which hand is it? (6-9 months)

- Close your hand around a small, interesting object.
- Open your hand to show the baby the toy. Close your hand.
- Ask the baby, "Where's the (name of object)?" Open hand again to show the object to the baby.
- Using your other hand, repeat the game.
- Soon your baby will grab your hand to try to reach the object.
- This game helps babies understand that objects placed inside containers do not disappear.
- It teaches exploration skills.

7 Fun Ways to Teach Kindness to Kids

- (1) Send kind thoughts. Think about someone they want to send kind thoughts to and then say out loud, "May they be happy. May they be healthy and safe. This practice helps kids to get into the habit of thinking kind thoughts more often.
- (2) Share stories of kindness.
- (3) Smile more often.
- (4) Play the compliment game. Toss a ball around and give a compliment to someone each time they make a throw.
- (5) Practice random acts of kindness.
- (6) Try empathy charades. Draw faces on the board and guess the emotion.
- (7) Volunteer for good. Whether its small or big actions, inspire your kids to involve in volunteer work. Teach them there is no limit to what your kindness can do!

Apple Frog for Kids
Total Time: 5 minutes

Ingredients

- 1/4 Granny smith apple, cored
- 3 green grapes, halved
- 1 teaspoon cream cheese softened
- 2 raisins

Instructions

- Lay the apple sideways on a plate. Cut out a thin horizontal silver for the mouth.
- Arrange 1 grape half on each side of the apple as arms. Cut out 2 little triangles from the other 4 grapes so they look like toes and fingers and arrange them as hands and feet. Shape cream cheese into 2 little balls and stick a grape into each as a pupil. Stick cream cheese eyes on top of the quartered apple.


